## Murray River Giant Pumpkin Competition Rules

## Weigh-in from 8:30am - 11am Easter Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> April 2019 Morgan Lion's Easter Bazaar

Seeds are free and, although all efforts are made to ensure viability, the organisers take no responsibility for germination. Please feel free to source your own seed.

The following rules will abide:

No foreign material (IE: fungicides, caulking, skin additives, etc) will be permitted in the weighing of the pumpkin. Vines must be trimmed to within 25mm of the stem.

The judges have the right to inspect any and all pumpkins before weights and measurements become official. Refusal of any inspection to an entry will cause the entry to be classed as exhibition only.

The pumpkin must be sound, healthy and undamaged. Entries must be free of rot, holes, or cracks through to the cavity, and serious soft spots.

The judges reserve the right to probe cracks, holes and to dig out soft spots to judge the pumpkin official or not. Before the judges can execute any of the previous they must have the grower present.

A serious soft spot is one that is greater than 75mm in diameter and greater than 75mm deep. The dimensions of the soft spot will be measured after all soft material has been removed.

If there are more than 2 soft spots that require material removed, the pumpkin will be disqualified even if each is smaller than a "serious soft spot".

The entry must be exhibited by the grower or team. In the case of an emergency where the grower or team cannot be present to exhibit the entry the judges will decide regarding the validity of the grower or team absence.

"GROWER" is defined as a person who has grown and cared for the entry, planting to harvest.

"TEAM" is defined as any two or more "GROWERS" that exhibit together.

GOURDS will include cucumbers, squash, luffa, and melons.

The surface area of the fruit grown in the garden, not including the portion that was in contact with or close proximity to the ground will be considered. This area will include the area between the ribs, around the stem and blossom end. This will not include any netting (cantaloping), any discolouration caused by the close proximity to the ground, or minimal amounts of white stripping or mottling associated with gourds.

PUMPKINS will be all fruit not classified as GOURDS.

Largest Other Vegetable must be for its type and not entered under Gourd or Pumpkin categories.

While multiple entries are allowed, only one entry will be eligible for a major prize. The largest/heaviest valid entry will be deemed prize worthy. All entries, provided paid for, will also be eligible for Novelty Prizes. The judge's decision will be final.

Winners of cash prizes are requested to supply Cadell Community & Tourist Association with Bank Details for cash prize transfer. Vouchers will be presented on the day. Winners should be in attendance, unless arranged with organisers prior to the day.

Winners will be requested to pose for promotional photos at prize giving ceremony.

All participants need to complete Pumpkin Competition Entry Form. Maximum cost per pumpkin entry will be \$15. This could consist of 1x Major Prize entry (\$10) and 1x Novelty Prize (\$5) for the same pumpkin.
